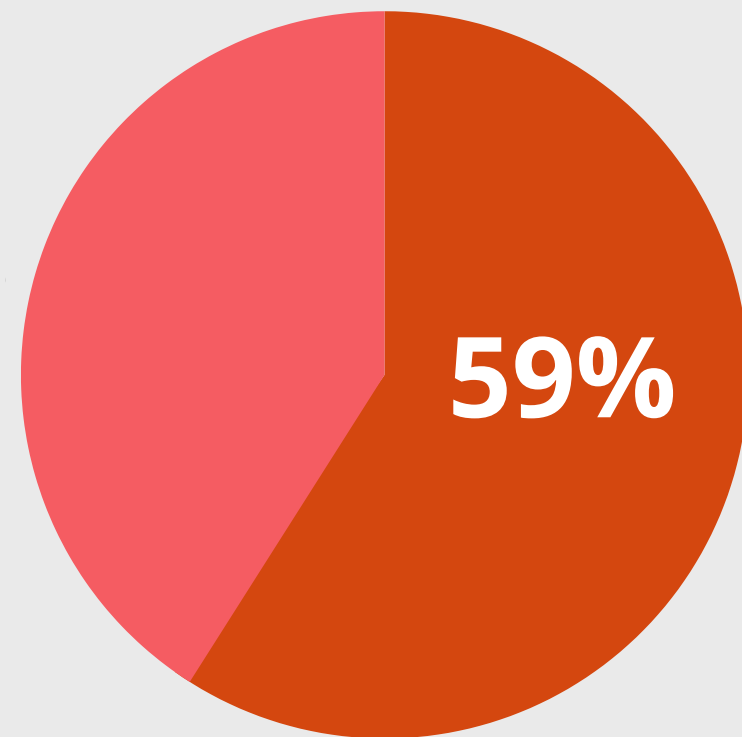
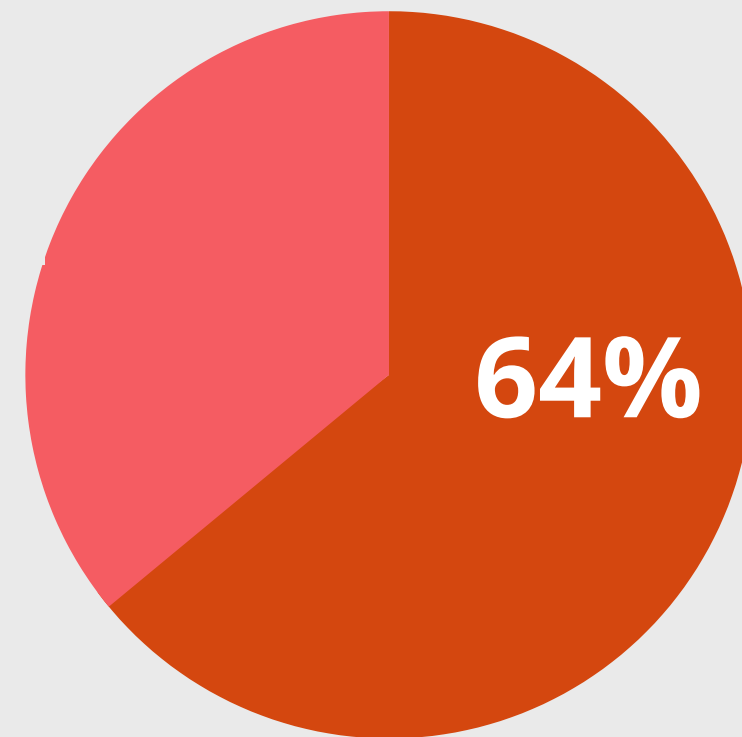


Poorer adults are less likely to have an annual dental visit

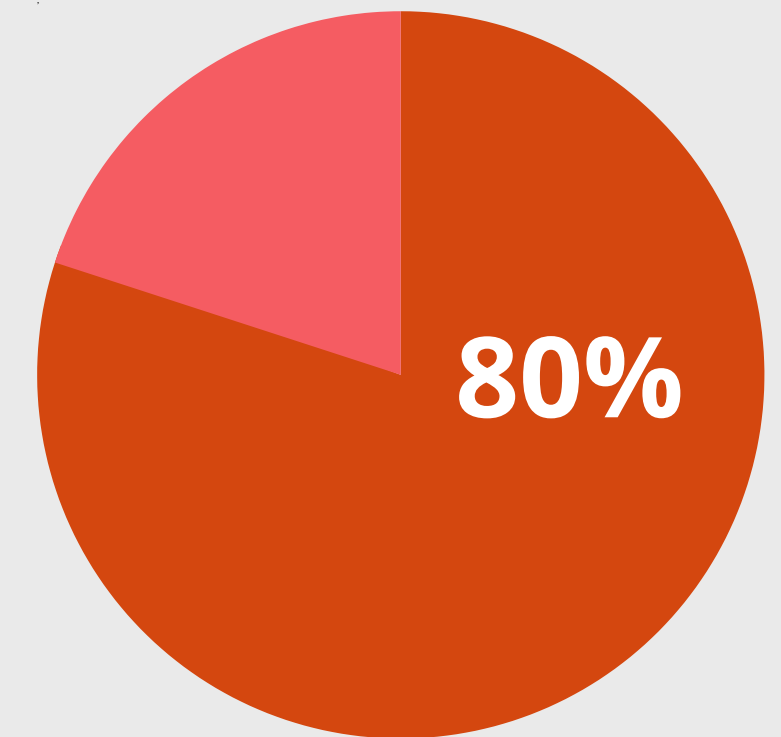
Percentage of California adults who had a dental visit in the past year, by federal poverty level (FPL).

249% FPL**



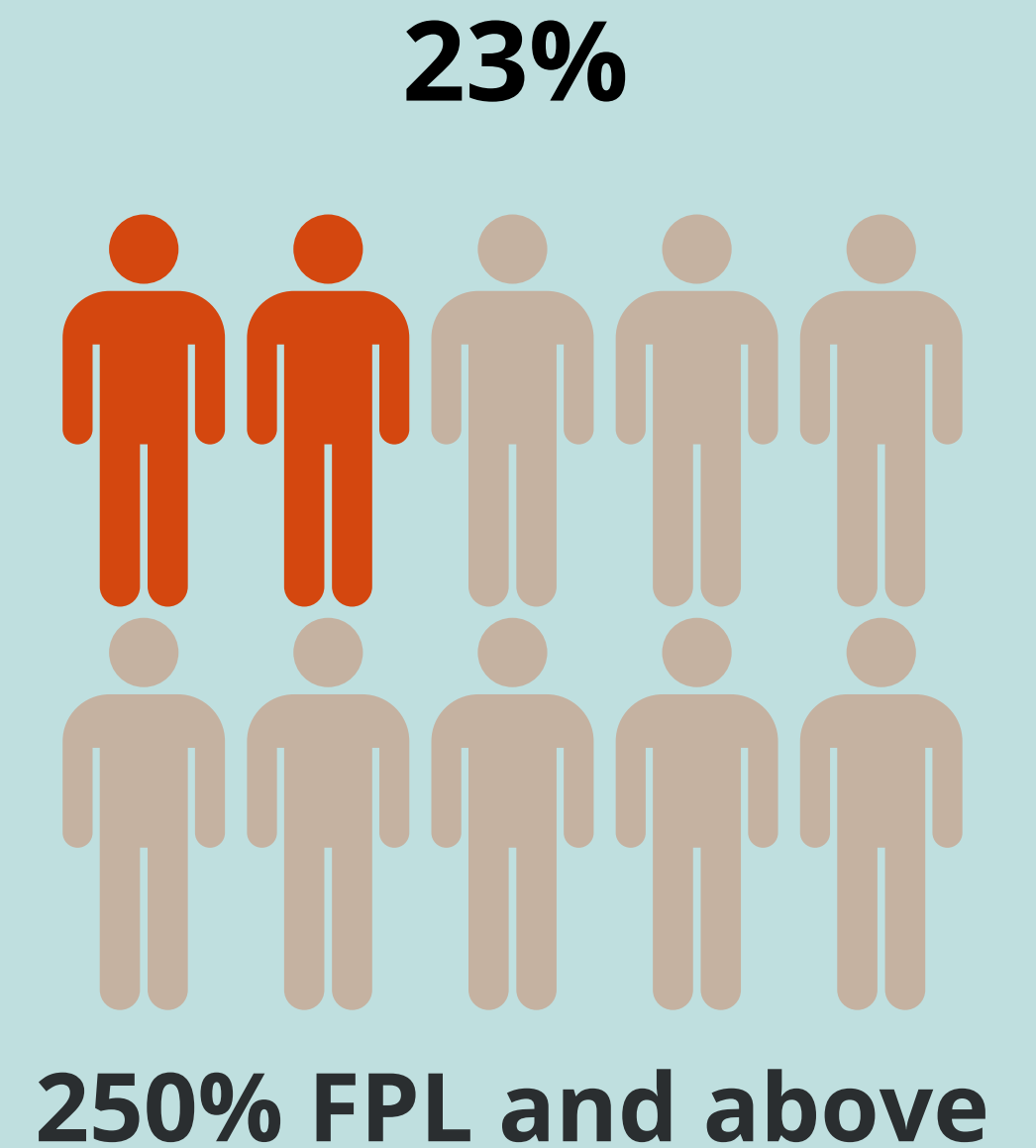
**250% FPL

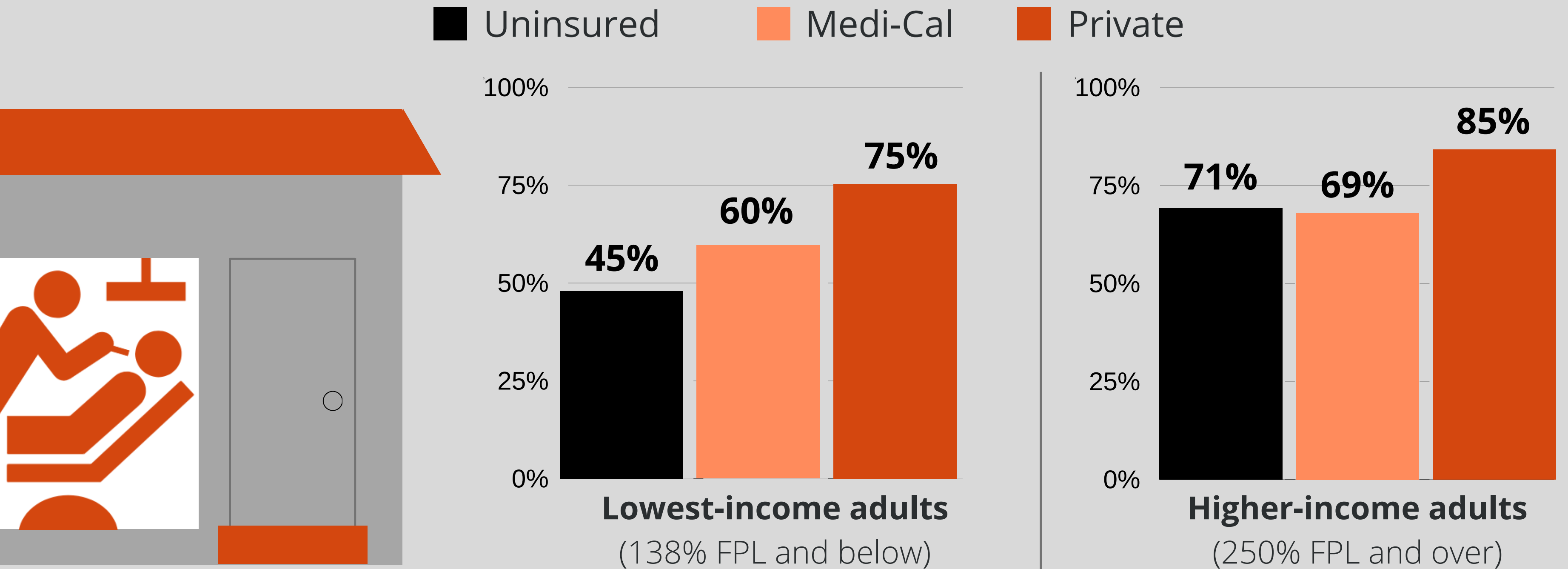
Lower-income adults more often need care for dental problems
