ADMISSIONS

The Fielding School matriculates students in the Fall term only and applications are due by **December 1** of the preceding year. All applications are reviewed holistically by a departmental faculty committee. To be considered for admission, applicants must submit the following materials:

- SOPHAS Application (sophas.org)
- UCLA Graduate School Application (grad.ucla.edu/admissions)
- Statement of Purpose
- Personal Statement
- Resume/CV
- Three letters of recommendation
- Official transcripts from all institutions attended. International applicants must submit transcripts through World Education Services (WES) for an official WES evaluation
- Official GRE scores (if needed by degree and department)
- Official TOEFL scores for international applicants only
