FELLOWSHIPS: To be considered for fellowships, applicants should express their interest on the SOPHAS and UCLA applications, and submit any required supporting documentation. Continuing students are also eligible for merit and need-based fellowships, including support for field work.

FAFSA: To qualify for FSPH need-based scholarships, federal student loans and work-study, students should submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
