RESEARCH AND CREATIVE ACTIVITIES:

My area of focus is on chronic health conditions, health beliefs and behaviors among American Indians and Alaska Natives. Current projects examine diabetes fatalism among the Plains tribes, smoking cessation, the cultural constructions of pain and depression among AIAN cancer patients and survivors. I am currently expanding into Indigenous populations research.
